President's Message

We are pleased to start the new year on a good note. We have hired a new choir director. Vasily Kifyak is an extremely talented musician who will join us on Jan. 1, 2020. We also have signed a 12 month contract with an interim pastor. Rev. Gwendolyn King will start on Jan. 6, 2020.

Vasily will start with the vocal choir and then in September will also direct the bell choir. Holly Donato will continue with bell choir until Sept. We appreciate all the work that Holly has done during this period of time when we had no choir director. Thank you. We also thank Alison Graham for helping with the vocal choir.

It often takes 18 to 24 months to call a new pastor but council opted for a 12 month contract with a month to month extension possible. We have a strong and dedicated congregation and council has already started much of the work necessary to nominate a call committee. There are 50+ seminarians expected to graduate this year but there are 24 congregations in transition. There may be other pastors seeking a move also. We need to complete our congregational profile and be in position to start interviewing as early as possible. Pastor Gwen is the chaplain at seminary so is in a good position to know who might fit our needs.

We have made a final contact with the Director of Transportation in Harrisburg to express concerns about the safety issues with the proposed Wawa construction. It appears that there will be no changes or work stoppage.

Our Congregational meeting will be held on Jan.19, 2020. Hope to see you all there.
